REFERENCE: WGA-55603, 19 January 1955 (not to POB) 200-6-12-81

1. A check of Headquarters' files has revealed no substantive information on reference request concerning:
 - a. "Cooperation between the Yugoslav and Soviet intelligence services";
 - b. "Cooperation between XAKO and ABAY on the one side and the Yugoslav intelligence service on the other side."

While there have been various rumors of such cooperation, we have not been able to substantiate them. F-6 is, therefore, the only evaluation we can give to reference report. Since, as far as we know, there is no Soviet advisor assigned to the Yugoslav service--as is the case with the other satellite services--the reported collaboration between these two services would appear to be questionable. The above may be passed to the BIV.

2. FYI ONLY: Reference is made to WLA-6255, dated 25 April 1951, which identifies Kalman ABAY (born 4 January 1899 in Pecs, Hungary) as a former member of the Tschardas Group of the GVL. He is stated to be a reliable, diligent worker of unobjectionable character. According to this report, Subject had started United States emigration proceedings.

3. EASA 19, 11 September 52, reported Col. Kalman ABAY (MILDSCHUEFZ) of Munich, Maria Teresia STRASSER 19/I, as an employee of the MHBK. According to EASA-1042, 19 March 53, ABAY was editor-in-chief of the MHBK periodical "Hadak Utjan".

4. We should be interested to know the Bavarian LfV's source of, and access to, reference report.
