6. From KUBARK files Headquarters has voluminous reports on Subject's Iron Guard affiliations, plus one report from [ ] listing Subject as an indirect collaborator of the Subot Institute in Munich, an institute long considered as being of interest to German Intelligence (MEM-86693 of 7 May 1957).
