MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Nicolae MALAXA

1. At 2:45 PM, 22 April 1952, Mr. W. W. Wiggins, Chief Investigations Section of the Immigration and Naturalization Service, called. He wanted to know when he could expect a letter from this Agency regarding subject which [] had stated would be forthcoming. Mr. Wiggins said that Mr. Benjamin Habberton, Deputy Commissioner, was very anxious to get the letter for the completion of the INS file on subject.
2. Mr. Wiggins further stated off the record that subject's case was now before Congress, but that there were certain intimations that it would not be passed upon by this Congress.
3. The Deputy Chief SE/SO, [], was advised of the above. He said that the memorandum on subject was now in final draft form and had been submitted to Chief SE, [], for approval. In view of the fact that the draft is also to be submitted to Mr. Wisner and Mr. Dulles, [] estimated that the final letter would not be ready for transmittal to INS before a week.
