"Subject is a free-lance correspondent for a number of WSCORNY papers. He has shown himself to be a competent journalist in a number of ways.

Deutschlands STIMME

"Subject published the Whitsuntide Identity (2). He obtained the financial backing of the Identity (3) for this project by his own efforts.

KAISER MINISTRY

"Subject again on his own initiative, but without government support or backing, published Identity (4). This publication is the subject of BRLN-3609 and received our backing in FRANG-1648 and WASHG -22635. As will be noted this was a one-time operation.

"As a result of these previous publications, it is felt that subject would be a valuable asset to this station. It is contemplated to use subject in similar operations as represented by the above.
