3. A propos [] CADRIER commented that Edward M. ADCOCK was very enthusiastic about his instructions to pay a call in Bonn. His reasons are general ~~SPSSB~~ antipathy toward the bureaucracy and specifically that he had nothing in particular to say to []. CADRIER was very much in sympathy with ADCOCK. (Apparently neither of them has guessed the nature of the []/KUBARK relationship. Perhaps, without dire security consequences, they could be informed in more detail ???)

4. Still on ADCOCK, CADRIER said there was a genuine danger that he'd work himself and his staff to death. He noted that most of the LCCASSOCK work was editorial - the assembling and editing of material from other sources. Every LCPAGAN product, however, was the result of creative as well as editorial effort. Adcock was doing a wonderful job and certainly ought to expand. However, the expansion would have to be accompanied by an increase in the staff before a serious danger of overwork arose.
