During a meeting with [ ] [ ] on 23 December 1958 he was informed of our reasons, per Reference A, paragraphs 6, 7 and 8 for not getting mixed up in any [ ] [ ] LCCASSOCK negotiations. He appeared to understand us perfectly. He expressed his appreciation, on a professional level, for our reluctance to make LCCASSOCK/1 aware of the [ ] [ ] contact and endorsed our refusal to expose KUBARK to LCCASSOCK/1. He still intends to approach LCCASSOCK/1 and sound latter out about his willingness to take the position as "Eastern Affairs Editor." He now considers doing this through an intermediary.
