1. With regard to the points raised in reference C, we should like to offer the following comments:

a. Since CAWASH is presumably unaware and cannot be informed by KUBARK of Nollau's existing psychological warfare activity, we suggest that could simply be advised that in the near future LCCASSOCK-1 plans to contact various Federal Republic offices engaged in anti-Communist matters--including the Interior Ministry and CAVATA--regarding his possible utilization in any type of anti-Communist activity. Such action would appear to be sufficient to minimize, if not preclude, any possible CAWASH impression that we are encouraging CAVATA to undertake activities outside its charter.

b. Presumably the reluctance to recommend LCCASSOCK-1, per paragraph D of reference C, stems from CAWASH-KUBARK PP liaison considerations. If so, a follow-up query to us by Nollau could be handled by a reply covering the general nature of LCCASSOCK-1's past work for us, together with a general recommendation of L-1, based on his past performance for KUBARK, but stopping short of any specific recommendation that Nollau employ LCCASSOCK-1 for PP purposes.

c. It would seem that it would be to the mutual advantage of both KUBARK and the Federal Republic that LCCASSOCK-1's undoubted talents and experience in anti-Communist activity continue to be utilized after the termination of LCCASSOCK. Since Nollau might in some way be able to utilize LCCASSOCK-1 or , a meeting between Nollau and LCCASSOCK-1 appears on balance desirable. At worst it would seem that such a meeting would serve merely to establish the fact that Nollau is not interested in utilizing LCCASSOCK-1's services.

2. In view of the reference C reservations, which seem largely to revolve around potential CAWASH representations to KUBARK should we take direct, overt steps to bring LCCASSOCK-1 to Nollau's attention and should Nollau employ LCCASSOCK-1 PP-wise, we suggest a modification of the reference B paragraph 5 proposal to exclude prior Bonn Base discussion of LCCASSOCK-1 with Nollau: BOB could steer LCCASSOCK-1 in Nollau's direction by including Nollau on a list of several Federal Republic officials engaged in anti-Communist activities who possibly might have some interest in LCCASSOCK-1. If Nollau subsequently follows up an LCCASSOCK-1 contact with a query to Bonn Base, Bonn Base could answer per paragraph 1b above. If Nollau should decide to employ LCCASSOCK-1, our reply to any possible CAWASH protest would be simply that LCCASSOCK-1 became a free agent upon our termination of him and that in response to Nollau's queries (should such have developed) we made the normal positive statement which we would have made to any querying Fedrep office.

3. We request your reconsideration of the reference C position in the light of the above.
