PERTINENT INFORMATION						
<p>b. Johann *MARGARIT (also spelled Ion or Jon, aka Jon or Ion *STANESCU and Jon *MATESCU; born 17 March 1914 in the village of Breaza, Epirus, Greece; also reported as born 19 March 1914 in Ciarnalia, Rumania); now living at Strobl 141, Land Salzburg, Austria; Margarit was recommended to Capt. Bier by Petri CONSTANTINESCU as a source of intelligence on the Satellites, especially Rumania. Since December 1957 or January 1958, Bier has met with Margarit about three or four times. Margarit offered Bier his services as a double agent against the Rumanian IS, claiming that he was called to the Rumanian Embassy in Vienna (date not known) and asked to work as an intelligence agent for the Rumanians. He further claims that he put the Rumanians off hoping to get German backing for a double agent role. He told Bier that, because of a misunderstanding, the Germans turned him down but he is ready to offer the same opportunity to the AMIS. (Station traces: Margarit ranks just somewhat below Constantinescu as an old-time intelligence peddler. He has been operating in the Salzburg area since 1945, was at one time on the American payroll, and was on the fringes of the old GROSSEBAHN group. Our most recent references to his activities are EGMA-19017, dated 17 January 1956, and EGIA 18284, dated 16 March 1956).</p>
