SPECIFIC— Death of Lyuba MATVILEYKO (nee DANLYUK)

1. Shlyakh Peremohy (BANDERA organ), dated 5 August 1956, published the following obituary:

"We inform the family, friends and Ukrainian community the sad news that our dearest wife, mother and sister, Lyuba MATVILEYKO nee DANLYUK, born 10 December 1914, at Khmil'n, povit Radelchiv, died after an operation on 27 July 1956, leaving five children, one (female) of whom was deported to Siberia. The deceased was a long-term OUN member, political liaison at Polish prisons, member of many societies, most recently the head of OUSH (Organization of Ukrainian Women) and directress of the children's camp at Schongau. Struck with sorrow are her husband and children, Slava MENSHINS'KA (nee DANLYUK), brothers Evhen and Roman MATVILEYKO, Lyuba CHAYKOV'S'KA, Genia MATVILEYKO and Dr. Bohdan TYLYK."

2. The above information is forwarded for the 201 file of Myron MATVILEYKO for reasons of the family relationship of the mentioned personalities.
