I was approached sometime ago by Jim McCargar on the question of his proposed book on Hungary. I knew that Mr. Frank Wisner interested himself particularly in such matters and I thought it best to raise the matter with him before doing anything more officially. Now I hear that Frank is ill and probably out of the running at the moment. I am therefore attaching various pieces of correspondence so that we can discuss this subject while I am in Washington.
