**MEISSNER, Gustav**

German, born circa 1914. Officer of Sipo & SD Copenhagen. Working under ~~record~~ diplomatic cover as Assistant Press Attache. Sent to the Eastern Front in the spring of 1943, but was reported in the following November to have returned to Denmark to recuperate from jaundice contracted on service. Last came to notice in March 1944 as head of the Press Section at the German Legation. Described as intelligent, but a fanatical Nazi and one of the most dangerous Germans in Denmark. Address (1944) German Legation, Kastelsvej, Copenhagen.
