SPECIFIC— Transmittal of AECAPELIN 2's Newspaper Article Translations

1. The following newspaper articles, translated by AECAPELIN 2, are transmitted for headquarters information; articles in Attachments A and B should be carded:

A. A series of articles written by Roman ILNYTSKY concerning events in Cracow during the latter part of June 1941 which affected the OUN and the Ukrainian government. Although these articles are one man's point of view, they should be a valuable contribution toward a study of this phase of Ukrainian political efforts. It is noted that numerous personalities of direct or indirect interest to KUBARK are listed in these articles which are entitled, "In Cracow on the Eve of 22 June 1941" and "The Events of 20 June 1941 and their Political Background".

B. An article entitled, "Oleksa HASYN, Chief of the UPA General Staff", written by Rev. M. SOPULYAK (see EGMA-15947).

C. Articles taken from German newspapers concerning the CERNAK assassination; note Immanuel BIRNBAUM's criticism of emigres in his article dated 7 July 1955. The article dated 23 August 1955 describes CERNAK's numerous contacts, including Alexander MATUS, Antonin KUBICEK, fnu MARKANCUK, Oberon HERBERT, Bruno FOLTA and Dr. Otto JOHN.

D. Four articles of an ideological nature written by Yevhen BURSHTYNSKY
(*) Evhen BOBIKEVYCH for the URDP/Left publication, Vpered (see EGMA-15923).

E. 11 articles from German newspapers concerned primarily with the existence of various Eastern emigre groups in West Germany and the effect of, and problems created by, these groups on German problems since Germany obtained its sovereignty.

F. Four articles from the Ukrainian emigre press concerning activities of Zch/OUN, KODUS, the publication of the journal, Ukraine, in the Italian language and the activities of "The Society of Ukrainians from Bukovina".
