1. Please don't forget that you promised us a PRQ on CAUTERY 2 as soon as he returned from vacation on 10 June. Now that we know (from your mention of his unemployment insurance - MIRA-9515) that he has no job, we are anxious to know how long he has been unemployed, what his cover reason is for not taking a job and whether it would not be advisable for him to find one that would consume a minimum amount of time.

2. We are also curious about his marital status, in connection with the "budding romance" with CAUTERY 10. The latter's personal relationships with the other CAUTERYs appear to us to constitute a potential security risk, but we are not in a position to assess her character in order to predict whether bitterness resulting from disappointment in any of these relationships might cause her to seek revenge by revealing the intelligence connections of CAUTERY 2 and 3 once she has realized the nature of their contact with CAUTERY 1. The same potential risk goes for CAUTERY 3 if and when he discovers 10's actual relationship to 1 and 2.
