THE LOSS OF AN ECONOMIC OFFICER POSITION AND A COMPLETE TURNOVER IN THE POLITICAL SECTION THIS CYCLE WILL GREATLY STRAIN OUR RESOURCES. REPORTING LIKELY TO BE FOREGONE BECAUSE OF THE ABOVE FACTORS INCLUDES POTENTIALLY USEFUL MAJOR PROJECTS STUDY BASED UPON THE GOVERNMENT'S NEW NATIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN. THE OUTGOING JUNIOR POLITICAL OFFICER IS SPENDING NEAR FULL TIME IN GETTING THE BIOGRAPHIC PROGRAM CURRENT, BUT AT THE EXPENSE OF OTHER POSSIBLE END-OF-TOUR REPORTS.
