1. An official of the United States Rubber Company, New York City, has advised KUBARK that subject, an employee of that company's Paris branch, was now in the United States for approximately three months home leave. Upon completion of home leave he would be returning to Paris. The official concerned did not interpose any objection to a KUBARK contact with subject.

2. For reasons best known to the headquarters element concerned, it is not desirable to request biographic data on subject from the official concerned. It is our thought that the Station may be able to determine subject's position and possibly learn enough concerning his contacts and abilities so as to arrive at a decision concerning further interest in the man.

3. If subject appears of interest to the Station headquarters will of course be glad to run full traces and request a POA if that is desired.
