A Byelorussian, born 25 December 1919, Subject arrived in the United States on 19 July 1954. In November 54, Subject was elected Chairman of the New York branch of the Byelorussian-American Association and has remained active in the Association to date. Subject claims fluency in Byelorussian and Polish; fair to well in English, Spanish and Russian; and fair in Italian and German.

Subject is employed as an accountant with the Holland-America Line in New York since 1954. He presently is being utilized as a spotter of Byelorussian Hot War Candidates as a Principal Agent for the Byelorussian package program and as an agent-spotter under Project AERPRIMER.

Subject presently is the Agency's only entre into the Byelorussian emigre community in the United States. He can report on Byelorussian emigre activities and supply spotting information for Hot War, REDSOX and REDSKIN candidates.

A polygraph and full Agency assessment were administered to Subject in August 1957. (SA C-26138 #153184) was granted Subject on 21 August 1957.
