

Siarhiej (Serge) Siniak alias Chmara

born in 1908-1910 in Russia. His parents and later himself lived in village Kazloušćyna (Kozloushtchina) near town Slonim, Byelorussia, (till 1939 Poland).

Now he is living in Canada, Toronto, address unknown to me. He (Chmara) is publishing a Byelorussian-language paper monthly "Byelorussian Voice" 306 Dufferin Street, Toronto, Ont. Canada, This address supposed to be the place he is living in.

His activity in Canada and the newspaper he published clearly indicate that he is an agent of Soviet Union, and among others his aim is to destroy by subversive actions the Byelorussian Liberation Movement abroad and particularly the organization of Byelorussians in USA and Canada.

He was a member of Communist Party of West Byelorussia (in Poland) and member of terrorist group, for what he was jailed in Poland, about these activity we refer to Byelorussian newspaper "Bačkaušćyna" (The Fatherland) published in West Germany of December 9, 1956 No. 50(332).
