RI Document #100-2-8-3192, dated 27 January 1954, is an operations memorandum. In addition to the usual description on the Subject, it is mentioned that he has a brother and a sister in White Russian Soviet but has received no news from them. Subject has not had any contact with his father in Poland since 1945.

One MIERLAK was a member of the White Russian Association in Argentina, Coronel Sayon 2981, Valentin Alsins, Buenos Aires, which he founded in April 1948 and presided during 1948-1950.

RI Document [] contains a report mentioning the Subject as chairman of the Manhattan Branch of the Byelorussian American Association (BAA).

A request was issued for R. I. Document [] but as yet the document has not been located. When the document is located, a supplemental report will follow if the file contains derogatory information.
