1. Mr. Mierlak, the Subject of References A. and B., whose contacts with two Soviet diplomats in New York City were called to your attention previously, has been named in Reference C. as being in contact with Aleksandr Romanovich SITNIKOV, Second Secretary of the Byelorussian Delegation to the U. N.

2. Subject is an SR/DOB contract agent employed as a spotter within the Byelorussian emigration.

3. In order to preclude any disaffection vis-avis the Agency and the Bureau, guidance is desired in the following:

- a. Notification of the Bureau that Subject is reporting his contacts with SITNIKOV to his Agency Case Officer.
- b. Transmission to the Bureau of the Subject's reports to the Case Officer.
- c. Notification of the Bureau that Subject is also in contact with N. SAKHAROV of the Soviet Mission in New York City, and also reporting these contacts to his Case Officer.
