SUBJECT: Baron Leopold Itz Edler von MILDENSTEIN  
born 30 November 1902 in Prague-Zizkow  
residing Wuppertal-Elberfeld, Worringerstrasse 97

1. SUBJECT was questioned in connection with the EICHMANN case.

2. According to his own statements he made a trip around the world in August 1936 which also lead him to the U.S. On this occasion he took out his first citizenship papers. He claims that possession of his First Papers permitted him to be employed in a civilian capacity with the Third Army at the time American troops entered Germany in 1945. He has been able to document the fact that he was first employed with the "Chemical Warfare Dept" (sic) and was later sent by the Americans as a supervisory engineer for the distribution of coal and cement to Land Bavaria.

3. Currently MILDENSTEIN has contact with the Near East - he has film representations in Bangkok, a petroleum business in Kuwait and connections with a number of newspaper offices.

4. M. claims that his main occupation is public relations man with the Coca Cola Co. in Essen.

5. During the interviews with SUBJECT he indicated that he is or was connected with an intelligence service without specifically stating which service.

6. We would appreciate receiving any information you may have on MILDENSTEIN.
