(ROME 398, 24 Oct 46) Subj recruited in Aug '46 by ANCONA Poles to create and co-ordinate Anti-Communist Polish-Hungarian Military Action. Visited Baron APOR in Rome. Oct. '46 in Austria.

(MAVA 3057, 9 Jun 49) Presently living at Gasthof Kirchenwirt in Absen, near Hall, Tyrol. Believes that he will be made chief of the Hungarian Saigre Army.

(NAV W 1124 dated 9 May 1949) Subj is married; about 45 years old; former Col. on General Staff. Good military connections in Hungary. Has men working in Hungary.
