The Goettingen publishing house Flesse Verlag, which is printing Dr. Werner Naumann's book "Nau-Nau Endangers the Empire, (Nau-Nau Gefaehrdet den Empire) has prepared for a first edition of 5,000 copies. The publishers have already received 3,500 advance orders. It was originally planned that Dr. Peter Kleist, author of the book "You Too Were There (Auch Du Warst Dabei), would edit the Naumann material, but Naumann finally undertook this work himself.
2. In his book Naumann relates that during one of his interrogations in prison, he commented that the proceedings against him adversely affected the strength of anti-Bolshevism and was a senseless business. To which the examining officer from London, whom Naumann names, should have replied, "What do you want? In 15 years we will all be under Bolshevik leadership and it will be good for us."
3. Flesse Verlag also plans to release a book in October entitled "Betrayed Germany" by Felix Schwarzenborn. The names Schwarzenborn and Euler are reportedly aliases used by one Dr. Johannes von Leers, who currently writes for "Der Tag", a German language publication appearing in Argentina. The thesis of the book will be that from 1932 on, organized forces from abroad were at work within the German government, the armed forces, and the Nazi Party, and were responsible for the outbreak of World War II and for Germany's defeat in the war.
