MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 201's Opened on the Basis of Untranslated Document,
MGSA-2941, 2 January 1951

1. This 201 was opened on the basis of information collected through IVAN MOROZ [] , Soviet Repatriation Committee agent in the Schweinfurt area of West Germany. His operations were carried out in several displaced persons camps through 1946 and 1947.

2. Contacts and agents of Moroz were listed with available D. P. camp records collected (apparently) by 66th CIC detachment. 201 files were opened in December 1953 by SR/3 (W3), presently SB/X/EU.

3. Data on these contacts is in the form of handwritten notes and camp records. They are in the German, Russian, and Polish languages. Because the material has changed hands several times, transliteration of names is very poor. The 201 Index records generally reflect no biographic data other than name and 201 number.
