NEW CHARACTERS AS OF NOVEMBER 19th

TRAEGER, Robert Charles @ BOB, the American. Arrested about October 21. An American by birth, but has lived in Germany since 1934. Former Feldwebel in Luftwaffe. Assigned to listen to Allied radio communications. Later placed in Marine Nachrichten Dienst under MEUNIER as technical radio advisor for G.I.S. agents in Le Havre area. Was to attempt to infiltrate American forces after invasion. Has described network of agents in Le Havre-Cherbourg-Calais-Boulogne-Dunkirk working under Col. STEINBERGER. Tried to commit suicide. Transportation to O20 under consideration.

MEUNIER, Robert. Arrested middle of October. Supervisor of TRAEGER and paymaster for group of agents in Le Havre area. Has worked for the Germans since 1935, and since 1941 with Marine Nachrichten Dienst, passing information to them. Between June and September 1944 received 2500 frs. per month and 600,000 frs. for an unexplained job. Has had W/T training. Interrogation continuing.

MAILLIEU, Julien. Well-to-do Frenchman at Le Havre arrested middle of October. Has worked for Germans since 1937 furnishing information through German Consul at Le Havre. Met ACHERMANN in 1940. Denies connection with G.I.S. but was in close touch with MEUNIER, from 1943 on. Was hiding two members of S.D. after invasion and undertook to hide TRAEGER. Has had W/T training and appears to have had a W/T set. Interrogation continuing.

NEBEL, Ludwig @ Leo NEUMANN @ Louis BAUMGARTEN @ Karl HAAS. Captured at Metheln on about November 1. Has blown Maurice ZELLER @ FORMANTIER and Ferdinand VLIEGEN @ VIENEUIL. A Sipo and S.D. Abt. VI saboteur and line crosser. Was to attack petrol pipe lines and contact one MARTIN in Paris, head of subversive French organization already supplied with arms and sabotage equipment. Had prepared sabotage dumps in German occupied territory. States there are 3 S.D. W/T stations in Paris.
(Note: As of November 12th this information had not been passed to French)

VLIEGEN, Ferdinand. Captured about November 12 at Reims. Recruited by NEBEL. French. Lieutenant of L.V.F. Same mission as NEBEL. Being brought to Paris for interrogation.

LUCKHAUS, Jean. Gave self up about November 4. Admits attempted recruitment by PEGASUS, but denies sabotage or espionage mission. Not yet broken.

HAAS-HEYE, Johannes. Arrested September 19 in Thorn and sent to Compiègne by P/W channels. Claims to be deserter from Luftwaffe. Has worked from 1935 - 41 for United Press, and Radio Mundial, Berlin, 1941 - 42. Connection with Sipo and S.D. uncertain. Being interrogated further.

PORTAL, Hajje @ REDJIE @ Portal SPADA @ SHTO. Arrested about November 1. Line crosser sent by KONDOR I.C. Mission undetermined.

Interrogation report expected. Held at Toul.
