NEBEL folder

BOORTMAN

One Ludwig NEBEL spent some six weeks starting about 6.8.43 at the A-Schule West between The Hague and Scheveningen. This was a school for training SD agents in sabotage and W/T.

NEBEL has stated that while he was at this school he noticed a man learning W/T for about ten days. This man was kept strictly apart from the rest of the students. He always wore dark horn-rimmed spectacles. BOORTMAN was later told by Obersturmfuhrer FELSMARK @ Arno BESEKOW that this man had been very successful in Salonica, where he was known as V-Mann 11. It occurs to me that BOORTMAN might be able to amplify this statement. In fact it seems to me not impossible the reference might be to BOORTMAN himself. According to the Y.P. of 30.12.44 BOORTMAN returned to Belgrade in the summer of 1943 for a short period to get his W/T speed up.

There is no reference in any O20 report to a journey to The Hague about this time. On the other hand, KRONBERGER stated that BOORTMAN flew to The Hague to procure for himself false Dutch identity papers to assist his scheme for settling down quietly and opening a boxing school in Salonica. KRONBERGER does not give a date for this journey.

I suggest it is worth while asking BOORTMAN about any journeys he paid to The Hague, and if the reference by NEBEL does not seem to fit
