- (i) MOULIA (VAR/3897 A.4.g) has unfortunately given himself up to Swiss police.

- (v) VIOLUX. French agent penetrating van de Castille set-up is being sent from Switzerland to Berlin.

- (vi) OSTRICH. (VAR/3897 a e.b.) Has been put through lines.

B. BELGIUM

- (1) In Luxembourg, Miss Vicky Dely, former S.D. typist, has given information on man now in U.S. Army who she claims sent to U.S. in 42 on S.D. mission.

D. GERMANY

- 1. In our opinion no real evidence for personal leadership of 150 Brigade by WROCKBY though Meinolt STIBULAN is Sharkey inspired.
- 4. Paris only. Your ALP/SH 157. We have now seen interrogation of Gunther SCHULTZ which does not alter above view.

Weekly progress report number 11 for week ending 20th January 1945.

1. Location of personnel. In Paris: 27700/A, D, O, P, R and Z  
In Lyons: 27700/Q. Travelling to Bordeaux: 27700/X and Hesse.  
At G A G 12700/K. In UK 27700/B and T.

2. Important Arrests.

(a) 4 PFF Frenchmen, OUSTIE alias COSTARD, CHIOCCA alias FRANQUI, FERRIERS or FERRIERS alias MARZIN and FOURNET alias MAIROT, were captured in Paris area on night 14th/15th January. They were equipped with W/T sets and some sabotage material.

(b) German sergeant arrested in AIN department on 16 January, wearing uniform under civilian clothes, who confessed being parachuted in December in LYONS area, now states he is an escaped P/W.

3. Important cases.

(a) STRACK. Interrogation by the French at present in suspense. TR and ourselves have asked for it to be resumed. TR are considering exploitation of Monte Carlo links in case.

(b) MARCIE. He will proceed to the UK on Tuesday 23rd January escorted by CAPTAIN VAUDREUIL and 27700/P.

(c) KAUFZ. He has been thoroughly interrogated in Paris by an officer of B I C E and by Captain HAMPSHIRE. A full report exists in manuscript form and will be available shortly. It is recommended that he be considered for O20 when this tactical interrogation is complete, as he is to be one of the most important agents captured here.

(d) COUPE. Interviewed by 27700/P in light of existing evidence against him, as French are still reluctant to arrest him. He aims at travelling to San Sebastian shortly. He has useful contacts in France, who are backing him in official French circles. He has closely been in touch with some German IS characters, but does not admit any pro-Axis activities.

(e) CHARRETIER. Called at British Embassy and asked whether a letter could be sent for him to Spain. He is still in Paris. It is not contemplated he should be arrested as the evidence is not sufficient. He is being watched by D.S. 200.

(f) MORTET. According to 27907/A, he will be available shortly.

(g) STOECHLING. 27907/A, now states subject is in hands of police judiciaire and cannot be sent to UK at present.

(h) REBERIN. Procedure for his return well in hand.

(i) VOOT. Is not established ~~Frenchman~~ to be TR agent and is at present in Madrid. BARATTE is also TR agent in touch with one CORNIER who has large P P P network (CXG 250 of 17th January refers).

#### 4. Development of DA cases.

(a) BRUTUS. 27700/C visited Paris on January 19th. In connection with proposal to send four of BRUTUS's former agents UQR 020. VAUDREUIL and HOBBS will attend conference in London on this case.

(b) OSTRICH. Was passed through Allied lines in direction of German lines on 15th January 1945. The three female AMT (ROMAE) six agents, ROUSWLET, LEROY and FRANCOIS who were thought to have crossed into Switzerland (on their way to Germany, are now known to have been arrested in Delle (France) early in January, having it is believed, obtained details of the location of the Allied Pipeline.

(c) BLACKGUARD. Contacted in Marseilles by 27700/ and JOWETT on 18th January. Visited Lyons to see his wife on way to Paris where he is due on 21st January. Full arrangements made for running case with TR.

(d) TRICYCLE. Left Paris with Capitaine LE MAN on 19th January en route for U.K.

(e) PEGASUS. Left France for Spain with PALETTE PILLIoux (believed to be P 174) who was mistress of ROBERT WYKER, on 7th January. This confirms your CXO 76 of 16th January. Full report on mission now available, including address of several W/T agents. TR provisionally agree to taking risk of PEGASUS visiting Ede 120, if and when he is asked to do so.

5. Priorities. 27700/D engaged in liaison with the French on current cases, including the CHARPENTIER case. He has also dealt with EBERTIER case. 27700/O now working from his hotel, has produced reports on Rouen area, cases, including SCHURMANN and MAUCOUSSIE, which will be forwarded to London shortly. 27700/P visited REVIE on Husec to give a lecture on the German IS to advanced CSDIC and to advise on the handling of CE cases. He has been in touch with the French concerning GOMI. He will escort MARCUS to the U.K. 27700/Q and JOWETT have made contact with BLACKGUARD in Marseilles. They are due in Paris on the 21st January. JOWETT will return as soon as possible to the UK. 27700/R is liaising with VERHBUIL on current cases, especially on parachute operations and French daily bulletins. He has been in touch with TRICYCLE and has arranged for his journey to London with Capitaine LE MAN. 27700/S returned to Bordeaux on the 19th January, after consultations in Paris concerning in Paris concerning Bordeaux area cases. He took part with HORSE and Colonel ROSS in conference concerning the Spanish frontier. 27700/Z paid a two day visit to Paris from Lille and is due to return on 22nd January. 27700/Y left for G.A.G. on 18th January. HORSE left on 20th January en route for Barcelona via Bordeaux and Toulouse. He

experts to arrive in Barcelona in ten days. Captain HAMPSHIRE continues his work on the OSTRICH set up with F B/27/B. It is proposed he should return for a short conference on 24th January.

6. Outstanding problems.

(a) Our Caracas residence and Mess had to be hurriedly closed on the 18th January to make way for a Lieutenant General. A tremendous problem of housing arose, which has temporarily been solved. A new location is being sought. No officers or secretaries should be sent here without SHARP authorization until our arrangements are complete.

(b) 27917 arrived back on 21st January. Miss Massey will return to London by the end of January but is indisposable at the moment as Miss Griffin is ill. Miss Griffin is finding climatic and other conditions difficult and her replacement should be envisaged.

(c) driver Oldfield. 106 SCI U<sup>11</sup> it will proceed WH shortly to collect one of the cars earmarked for us, as all military transport is under repair. Our drivers are consequently without work.
