Following are traces of individuals connected with the NEBEL Case:

V/48/P.6

1. Alfred NIKLES & Dr. HUTTEN - Merchant, born 1907. Secretary of B.T.E. and Chief of military organisation, the "Schutzkorps". Was connected with setting up of secret W//T station at Interlaken. Supplied agents to Information Bureau. Gave orders for picketing of Consulates. Engaged agent to watch Marxist organisations in Schaffhausen. From Worben. Tried on 11.7.39 for espionage and sentenced to six month's labour. In 1943 sentenced to 2 years in default.

2. Jean CHARLES - "Agent d'Affaires". Office address: Quai Bergues, 23, Geneva. Private address: 5 Rue Topfer, Geneva. Was reported in 1941 to be setting up a Société Anonyme for the distribution of coal in Switzerland, the profits to go to the "Mouvement National Suisse", secretly re-founded by Swiss subjects so that there should be no complaint of German interference in Swiss affairs.
