Subject: Location of Amt VI/S Sabotage Dumps.

Hans KUSZAK gave the following information on the location of Amt VI/S sabotage dumps:

1. The first dump is in the Hardt Forest. Take the road from Mulhausen to Mulheim until you come to a canal. Cross the canal by the bridge and the dump is located about 600 meters from the canal on the right in the woods.
2. The second dump is reached in the same manner but it is located about 400 meters from the canal on the left.
3. The third dump is located between Mulhausen and Kolmar. Take the road from Mulhausen to Kolmar and about one kilometer from Kolmar the road crosses a little stream. There is a path on the Mulhausen side of the stream on the right side of the road. Follow the path past a pasture for about 200 meters and there is another path on the right. Follow this path for 100 meters and turn left in the woods for 20 meters.
4. The fourth dump is also on the road from Mulhausen to Kolmar. About five or six kilometers from Mulhausen there is a path on the right side of the road. Take the path for 600 meters and on the left side of the path in the wood there is a pole which was part of an old funicular. Behind the pole is an embankment which was formerly used for a railway. The dump is at the bottom of the embankment.

KUSZAK says the dumps contain the following material: one impregnated box about a square meter in size containing two containers of plastic three Sten machine guns and 800 rounds of ammunition. Also there are some detonators and some Bickford cordons.
