3. PENETRATION PROGRAM

c. OSTRICH and JIGGER. Action has been initiated to obtain cover jobs for OSTRICH and JIGGER with Ludwig FUCHSL, Munich, Implerstr. 9a. FUCHSL has requested authorization from Military Government to organize a firm for salvaging wrecked trucks and cars for transport and for carrying food supplies. As employees of this firm, OSTRICH and JIGGER will be able to circulate throughout Bavaria with good cover for their activities. They will be on their own and will report to us when necessary. JIGGER made contact with a Professor Dr. Ing. W. E. FAUNER of the Technische Hochschule of Berlin (Wehrtechnische Fakultät) who is now living at Dingolfingen. FAUNER was a specialist in armament and collaborated with the OKH on scientific research. He is also believed to have information concerning the sale of the V-1 weapon to the Japanese. JIGGER learned that Leo BRANDT, Reichstell für Industrielle Fette, one of the biggest dealers of fats in Germany and whose office in Paris was used as a cover for the Abwehr, is now living in Garmisch. In addition JIGGER was informed by Ludwig FUCHSL that SKORZENY and several members of Amt VI/8 frequently went to Aschtal near Salzburg. It is believed that there is an Amt VI/8 dump at Aschtal and an investigation will be made.
