1. Attachment to reference pointed out Robert A. Ascham's interest in current whereabouts and activities of Subject, along with a request to UTILITY for any information he might have. [] has just learned from an American acquaintance of the NEUBACHER family that Subject is currently living in Vienna and frequently travelling to and from Bonn where he is in contact with many old contacts and friends in the Foreign Office. In fact one of his purposes is to arrange for establishment of his pension as a bonafide war-time employee of the German Foreign Office. Helping him in this endeavour is said to be his ex-son-in-law (Baron?) Charles CHAPEUX-ROUGE described as a Senator from Hamburg, W. GERM.
2. According to this same source Subject, despite opposition from the British and French foreign offices, was hired a couple of years ago by Haile SELASSIE to serve as an economic consultant for Abyssinia but failed to have his contract renewed because he refused to engage in the necessary palm-greasing procedures one needs to hold a job in that part of the world. He is currently said to be dickering with some unspecified oil interests in the Iraq-Iran area but is again running into British opposition. Also reported is an assertion that NEUBACHER is on very good terms with the Austrian Chancellor, Julius RAAB, who is allegedly trying to find a slot for him somewhere in the Austrian Government. This is a prospect that would go over like a lead knoedel with the SPOs, I'm sure.
