1. In 1948, Károly NEY was in close contact to Dr. ECETTL. He was supported by CIC, GUMPERT and had his headquarters in LAIBACH. He is the leader of the ALA, an organization of Hungarian emigrants which is similar to a military organization. This organization, however, exists more or less only on paper and in the imagination of NEY. Actually it is not of any importance.

NEY has no capabilities and knowledge of intelligence work, a fact that caused disagreements between NEY and Dr. ECETTL. Dr. ECETTL and his circle consider NEY as careless, incapable and lavish.

Therefore, NEY contacted the French IS; on 16 November 1948 he had a meeting in FREYBURG/Breisgau with a representative of the French IS. Through the French he obtained a pass for Italy.

In January 1949 NEY asked for 20,000 shillings for a trip to Spain to visit FRANCO which Dr. ECETTL refused. At that time he broke of the connection with Dr. ECETTL.

2. On 8 February 1949, NEY, under the covername Dr. KIRO B. KREP, had a meeting with one of our coworkers. (NEY had asked for that conference.) During this conference he explained his plan to organize a new international anti-bolshevist movement. He wants to found a group of anti-bolshevist emigrants of Eastern Europe in the US zone of Germany. He also mentioned his close contact to the French who support him and supply him with papers etc. After this meeting our coworker - D. order - broke of the connection with NEY.

3. No further information is available on other meetings of NEY in TUNIS or on his activities. A son of KRIEDEL is not a member of our project.

4. This office knows that NEY traveled to ROME in December 1948 and in March 1949. We also know that NEY contacted Hartmann LAUTERBACHER and the Arab MEJDUB in ROME.

Hartmann LAUTERBACHER was the former "Reichsfuehrer of the Hitlerjugend" and later the Gauleiter of HANNOVER.

Abdul-Medj ~~MEJDUB~~ is an Arab, born on 17 July 1916 in TUNIS. He worked during the war in the Reichssicherheits-hauptamt VI. Allegedly, he was sentenced to death in absentia by the French.

No information is available on the foundation of an organization WEASEL in ROME.
