During the war opposed the Hungarian government and the right radical circles. Formed an Hungarian SS and gave himself up to the Germans. After the war was sentenced by the Americans to death, later, however, was pardoned. He is considered as an ardent anti-communist. 3. <u>NEY</u> , a Hungarian Major, was to be the head of the intended intelligence organization in Hungary. He was to be assisted by:

III. Notes:			
On Par. 3: <u>Maj. NEY</u> alias <u>KABSZ</u> , head of the Hungarian Union of Veterans of the War against the SU, moved to LAMBACH. He intended to start intelligence activities against Hungary, establish an active opposition group in Hungary proper, unify the Hungarian emigrants on a non-partisan basis. A training camp for agents was established in GRUENAU. <u>NEY</u> is said actually to have sent agents to Hungary. Because of financial difficulties and disagreements in opinion concerning the tactics of intelligence work, <u>NEY'S</u> group called "AMA" and the group of HOETTL-KERNMEYER soon opposed each other. To make the "AMA" financially independent of Dr. HOETTL, <u>NEY</u> took up connection with the French. He allegedly traveled twice to FREIBURG im Breisgau, where he is said to have conferred with officers of General KOENIG. Dr. HOETTL reacted by disconnecting his intelligence organization from the "AMA". Thus, <u>NEY</u> at present has only the resistance organization of the "AMA" at his command, but not the intelligence organization against Hungary which was taken over by KERNMEYER. The GRUENAU training camp was dissolved.

On Par. 4: Under <u>NEY</u> , KERNMEYER was in charge of the press service and of commitment of agents.

After <u>NEY</u> had been deprived of his influence (see above), KERNMEYER moved to ALTUEENSTER near GRUNDEN and became the head of the intelligence organization in Austria in addition to his intelligence mission against Hungary.

Data concerning persons 20. <u>Dr. Karoly NEY</u>, a Hungarian; was born 9 November 1906 in BICSSZENTIVAN; formerly manager of a leather factory in BUDAPEST; former Major; during World War II, strongly opposed the Hungarian Government, and later also radical Rightists; activated an Hungarian SS detachment which he subordinated to the III German Tank Corps; after World War II, was sentenced to death by the Americans, but was amnestied later; is considered to be dauntless person and a staunch anti-Bolshevist; is difficult to get along with because of his arrogance.</p>
