Agent Report:			
THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS QUOTED VERBATIM			
<p>In July 1950, SUBJECT received an invitation from Countess (fnu) WRBNA-KAVNITZ to come to Munich to live with her. Since SUBJECT was destitute, he accepted the invitation and went illegally to Munich. In Munich, he met Baron Zeigmond HUSZAR who told SUBJECT that he had 15,000 Soviet-make sewing machines and 10,000 Soviet-make contax cameras for sale. SUBJECT sent this information to HEGEDUES who requested SUBJECT to obtain as much information as possible about the firm from which HUSZAR had obtained these items. SUBJECT then learned from HUSZAR that the name of the firm was KASPAR, located at Turken Strasse 17, Munich. SUBJECT also learned that this firm was engaged in extensive trade with the Soviets dealing mostly in coal and sewing machines. All accounts of the firm were settled in free dollars at the Landan Bank Verein, Zurich, Switzerland. SUBJECT also learned that one member of the firm was a <u>Karoly NEY</u> alias <u>Dr. KIRSCHBERGER</u>, living at Putzweg Strasse 1, Munich, Phone No. 8821.</p>			
<p>Numerous reports in the files of this Sub-Detachment identify <u>Dr. Karoly NEY</u> as a former Hungarian Partisan Organizer and anti-Communist who was once sentenced to life imprisonment by a USWC Court and who afterwards is alleged to have engaged in extensive intelligence activities.</p>
