ORG BACKGROUND:

ROD date until 1 March 54, Subject was assigned to D. St. 11.
1 March 54 until ca April 54 Subject was assigned to Sec. 511.
On April 54 Subject was assigned to Sec. 900 working directly
for GUNDEMANN handling security violations and investigations.
In March 56 it was reported that Subject was Chief of 900/NORTH
STROM. It was not indicated how long he had held this position.
In March 58 it was reported that Subject was with D. St. 12 working
under FREY in Hamburg and scheduled to move from the Munich area.
At various times during Subject's career with the Org he was considered
as a Special Connection.

Known to ALBERT

Subject reportedly replaced SPREY as leader of Det 12. He was formerly
900's Chief. DOI: Feb/59 - [redacted] contact report. GUNDELER had
advised Gellner that GUNDELER, a former Det 11 type, was the new leader of Det 12.
