1. The leaflet attached to the reference is a noteworthy effusion in more ways than one. The undersigned will only point out that by summoning Albanians to listen to something called R.F.A. (presumably Radio Free Albania) [ ] has inadvertently helped to increase the confusion between the Voice of Free Albania and Radio Free Europe.

2. Secondly, by introducing in a rather off-hand way the notion of prolonged applause as a method of negative resistance, the leaflet has added to our own confusion on this question. Up to now, as stated in 1606 CAGWU, we were under the impression that QKFervor and [ ] disapproved this suggestion and we had decided to shelve it until some future date.

3. Since it has now been revived and introduced into Albania via the reference leaflet, it might be advisable to attempt to make something of it. Certainly [ ]'s handling leaves the matter rather lamely up in the air. Washington's and [ ]'s view on this matter are earnestly solicited.
