The following information was given by Little Pine, after being urged, during the final stage of the debriefing.

1. The following persons left the Communist Government of Albania and crossed into Yugoslavia. They have been imprisoned by the Yugoslavs as political prisoners.

It is not known which are still living but it is known that all were imprisoned by the Yugoslav Government.

2. Armed informers in Shtigen, the population of Shtigen is unknown, however, from our information with reference to the number of armed persons per village Shtigen would be in the 200 home bracket, this is only an estimate and should be evaluated as such:

3. Following is a translation of an open letter sent to Albania emigrants in Yugoslavia and prominent members of the Prizren Committee.

"People of Albania - Brothers and Sisters - you should do everything possible to get away from the Hoxha regime and to cross into Yugoslavia because here in Yugoslavia we have political and economic assistance.

"We have sent a group into Albania for the purpose of compiling a list of names with the purpose of sending arms into Albania to be scattered among the population, however, this plan has been slightly changed".

Note: Spahiu has said and says on numerous occasions that Albania will be liberated only with the assistance of Yugoslavia and no one else. Spahiu has carried on a great deal of work among the Albanian emigrants in Yugoslavia.
