SUBJECT: Daily Progress Report for Tuesday, 9 September 1952

1. BQFIEND - An SE representative has reported from Cairo that King Zog expressed concern lest his emissaries at the recent Skoplje meetings be rushed by the Yugoslavs into a low level relationship either with the Prizren Committee or with Macedonian Republic officials. Our representative urged the King to insist on contact through the highest echelon of the Yugoslav Government he can reach and to prevent the development of any situation which would permit the Yugoslav Prizren Committee to use his name. Zog stated he was aware of the latter danger and that he intended to insist on the full participation of the NCFA in any activities involving the Prizren Committee. King Zog also said that the Yugoslav Ambassador in Cairo has stated that he is certain there is something important going on with respect to Albania of which his government is aware but he is not informed in detail by his government.

Zog agreed that Lutfi Satfet Tozan should be eliminated as a channel of communication with Tito as soon as possible and stated that if Tozan's recent talks with the Yugoslavs fail to produce satisfactory results he plans to use Misrahy Pasha, his Egyptian lawyer, to reopen conversations. Zog stated that the British had called Tozan to London and that they are not pleased with the former's dealings with the Yugoslavs.
