1. Personnel

Provision of material to [ ] for P/W activities on a routine basis.

4. Operational Activity

a. Operational activities implemented or acted upon

(1) Apple Tree Team remains in Albania. A successful resupply drop to the team was executed on 29 January. Throwoff/2 and four cargo containers were delivered. All negative control signals have been received in subsequent W/T contacts.

(2) Observant. Cadunce is in the process of making a card file on Albanian refugees in this area.

(3) Oblavate. Gaccont continues to report on activities at Lavrion.

(4) We have contracted with a firm of architects to construct a pier and road at the training site. Work is scheduled to begin the week of 16 February. The same architects have drawn plans for the permanent house to be constructed at the site and final cost details are being settled now. A formal contract will be prepared in the near future.

b. CE Activities

c. Future operations in planning stage - recruitment of training program

(1) We have been advised of three team leaders to be provided by RNCASTING. We are planning on at least two more.

(2) Throwoff/2 has joined Apple Tree Team and will henceforth be regarded as a member of that team.

(3) The four W/T trainees from Germany are receiving their advanced training here as is Gadammy on whom we received an operational clearance this month.

(4) Matiani, Gash, Alikaj and Flaku are standing by for 1953 operations.

(5) AIBKAT's polygraph test was favorable and he will be put to work as soon as an operational clearance is received.

d. Inactive operations

(1) Willow Team members are being sustained on the local economy pending their next assignment in the spring.

(2) Pig Team members are being sustained on the local economy pending their next assignment in the spring.

(3) Throttler Team members are being sustained on the local economy pending their next assignment in the spring.

e. Terminated operations

(1) Koci Dule has been moved from Siros to Lavrion.

(2) Hajrullah Terpeza has been moved from Kithira to Lavrion.
