(2) Highlights of the month's traffic are:

- (a) Throwoff/2 advised us of his safe landing and the team's recovery of all the four supply containers dropped with him on the 29th of January.
- (b) After an engagement with civilian Communist forces Apple reached a quiet area to the east of their DZ. RNDomino is now safe and adequately provided with medicine.
- (c) ~~Balluku's~~ disappearance is confirmed by Apple.
- (d) Airtight has accepted our instruction to exfiltrate in the spring to give a full report of activities to date.

b. Observant

(1) Gadunce is in the process of making a card file on Albanian refugees in this area.

c. Oblavate

(1) Gaccent continues the report or activities at Lavrion

4. Training Site

a. [] and [] made a trip to the Greek Army Engineers School at Loutraki the 12 and 13th of February to arrange for support in the construction of the site. The Commandant of the school has agreed to provide a bulldozer and an air hammer required for initial construction work.

b. Negotiations are underway with the Greek Navy for the loan of a large landing craft for use in transporting building materials and equipment to the site.

5. Action Outstanding - Washington

a. Provision of radar equipment for use as cover for the training site.
