MEMORANDUM FOR: CHIEF, POLITICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL WARFARE

SUBJECT: Daily Log.

EGFIEND.

The EGFIEND representative [ ] charged with dealing with the NCFA, reports that he has become convinced that the working relationship between himself and his British opposite number may be breaking down. He is of the opinion that the British are attempting to establish independent control over some components of the NCFA, and that they may have established an independent liaison with the Yugoslavs regarding Albanian affairs. While there is no question in his mind that the British services are entitled to act as they like, he points out that their following an independent course in this instance violates the sense of the U.S.-British services arrangement presently in force regarding Albanian emigre matters.
