1. Based upon present capabilities for operations in Albania, FY 1953, goals for HQFIEND have been established as follows:

a. Political Warfare. To weaken by all available means the internal position of the Hoxha regime while conversely strengthening the relative political position of the National Committee for a Free Albania.

(1) Action to achieve this goal has resulted in the creation and organization of the National Committee for a Free Albania with offices in New York and Rome for the purposes of uniting Albanians in exile and serving as a cover for operations. In addition psychological warfare activities *and* having a direct bearing on this goal have been conducted.

b. Psychological Warfare. To harass the Hoxha regime while simultaneously urging the populace to maintain a passive resistance. This to be implemented through leaflet and consumer goods drops, black radio broadcasts, and NCPA publications.

(1) Operation of a clandestine radio transmitter, the Voice of Free Albania, in the name of the NCPA which broadcasts thrice daily into the country.

(2) Semi-monthly publication of a four-page Albanian language newspaper, Shqipëria, by the NCPA, miniature editions of which are periodically air-dropped over Albania.

(3) Monthly publication of the Albanian News Bulletin in Albanian, English, French, and Italian by the NCPA in Rome for distribution to Albanians in exile.

(4) Air-drop of 4,358,000 leaflets since 16 October 1950 over Albania. Six flights.

(5) Air-drop of 3100 cans of scarce consumer goods and 1000 one pound bags of flour since 19 December 1951 during three flights.

c. Agent Operations. Carefully and systematically to develop one or more small secure underground nets aimed at penetration of the army and government. These nets will be gradually developed and expanded with the ultimate goal of undermining the government and creating a resistance potential to be used in event of war or revolution.

(1) Infiltration of 11 teams into the country for the purpose of collecting intelligence, assessing resistance potential, contacting potential defectors in the army and government structures, establishing escape and evasion and intelligence networks, and recruitment of potential agents. At the present time there are two active teams in the country, one of which is in contact with the field headquarters via a W/T link.

d. Economic Warfare. To develop and implement an economic warfare program directed at Albania.

(1) To date the economic warfare activities outside the country are limited to the planning stage due to the limited facilities which exist for employing economic warfare methods against Albania.

(2) Economic Warfare inside the country cannot be conducted until agents establish secure means of carrying out such activities.
