MEMORANDUM FOR [ ]

1. We have just received through our intelligence sources inconclusive information which indicates that the Greeks may be in process of mounting an operation into Albania which would involve the use of Albanian agents and organizers. We are seeking further details through these sources and are also making inquiry of Van Fleet.

2. As this will, of course, have bearing on our joint plans, we should like very much to know whether or not you have any information which would tend to confirm or refute these reports, or which would provide more precise information on the nature and extent of such operations.

3. We hope that we will be able to obtain further information ourselves from the above source, and therefore request that your Services refrain from making any special query to the Greeks on this subject, as we are concerned lest this prejudice our sources and cut off opportunity of learning fuller details.
