Reference [] of November 18th.

- A. While we view this solution with considerable misgiving as likely to raise future problems, we would accept repeat accept it if Committee themselves agree on it.
- B. We believe however that opposition foreshadowed in [] para.G. will probably result in rejection of proposal.
- C. We therefore urge that we should proceed as suggested in our telegram addressed WASHINGTON 48/49 repeated [] of November 18th. Arrangements can always be cancelled if Committee agree on solution in meantime.

Department Comment: Paragraph C. refers to a suggestion that [] and OPC representative should stand by to go to [] approximately November 25th with powers, if Committee fail to agree, to accept a rotating chairmanship.
