MEMORANDUM FOR: []

1. With reference to your memorandum of 30 January 1950, the following information has been provided in response to the queries contained therein:

a. Aircraft Equipment.

(1) The equipment installed in the aircraft was a Motorola "Dispatcher" FM transmitter/receiver and a wire-recorder to monitor both incoming and outgoing broadcasts.

(2) The power output was 7-10 watts.

(3) Both a "whip" and a "ground-plane" type antenna were installed on the aircraft.

(4) The complete installation was made in one day.

(5) The frequencies were 151-152 megacycles.

b. Ground Equipment.

(1) The ground equipment was a Motorola portable FM transmitter/receiver.

(2) Its power was approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ watt.

(3) The type antenna was "whip".

(4) Battery life is approximately 10-15 hours of continuous operation.

(5) The frequencies were 151-152 megacycles.
