SPECIFIC— Trial of Allegedly American-Trained Spies in Tirana

*Re General Operational Matters - Albania*

1. The following transmission from Radio Moscow in Serbo-Croat, on 24 May 1950 at 8:00 p.m., monitored in Trieste, is forwarded for your information:

"The trial of the spies and deviationists Edhem GAKA, Lukman LUFTI and Kaza JUFO, who were parachuted last year on Kurbelesi Mountain in southern Albania, began on 24 May. The defendants had completed special espionage courses in Naples, directed by representatives of the American Intelligence Service in Italy. The newspaper VERI I POPULIT (Voice of the People) writes that, as is clear from the statements of these spies, all Albanian war criminals are in the service of the British, Italian, Greek and TITO's intelligence services. The main center of these espionage networks is the American Intelligence Service".
