SUBJECT: Airline Operation in Europe

1. The following information is forwarded regarding the possibilities of using  Airlines for special operations into Greece:

A. It is possible to transport six men from Germany to Greece, non-stop, at a cost of \$6,500. DC-3  
 This same flight can be accomplished if one gas stop is permitted at a cost of \$3,600. If the passengers do not leave the plane there are no restrictions on landing in foreign countries. 46

B. If needed it will be possible to charter a plane from time to time for men or supplies or both. No price has been established for an operation of this kind.

C. At this time all European crews of  are being security cleared and it will be possible, if the need arises, to charter a plane and crew for as long as desired.
