SUBJECT: Progress Report for April 1951

1. Radio. Owing to the continued delays in getting KMhymnal ready for operations, there is little progress to report in the field of BQFlame/BQFlame radio. It is planned to make a preliminary cruise at the earliest possible moment in order to survey the grounds where KMhymnal will be operating in the future. The chief purpose of the trip is to investigate possible sites on Identity (1) from which KMhymnal could operate while at anchor in protected waters. If such a site is available it has been agreed to acquire it as a base to provide shelter for KMhymnal during the period of heavy weather which in these waters sets in approximately 15 November. During this period, according to those who have some experience with KMhymnal in heavy weather, it will be virtually impossible to operate regularly. The further purpose of the preliminary cruise is to investigate the limitations to KMhymnal's freedom of movement imposed by the presence of Identity (2)'s of LCFlake origin and maintained regularly by the LCFlake Identity (3).
2. Leaflets. No leaflet operations were carried out during the month in view of the ban imposed by ZRMetal. Leaflets continue to be planned for future distribution. ZRMetal has been informed of developments along this line by previous correspondence.
3. Mail Campaign. As stated in previous correspondence, a national BQGypsy circular has been prepared, reproduced and given to the TFSpider team which has been awaiting a favorable opportunity to drop into TFSpiderland for the past two weeks. Other aspects of the mail campaign have been covered in previous correspondence.
4. Printing Press. The printing press and auxiliary equipment arrived in the course of the month and has been stored in the warehouse in their crates. It will remain there until personnel to operate it also arrives. The paper stocks ordered by ZRMetal have not yet arrived.
5. Personnel. In the course of the month Identity (4) arrived in LCDrink from TFGredo, and immediately began to work as clerk and translator for Uridge and company.
