DAILY REPORT - WEDNESDAY 20 JUNE 1951

BGFIEND

1. The first effort to resupply the two-man team dropped in the Kukës region on May 18/19 was made on the night of June 18/19 without success. No lights were seen on the ground at any of the points designated for the drop. A second effort was scheduled for the night of June 19/20. No report has been received on this operation.

2. The "Kosovar" team which was reported imprisoned by the Yugoslavs in Prizren, in the FIEND daily report of 13 June, have sent a letter from Prizren dated 7 June to the effect that the team is still safe and operating. It is interesting to note that the team is located with the cut-out who served them during the past six months; our report dated June 13 indicated that this cut-out was dead.

3. One of the members of the Dibra team has also sent an additional letter to the Committee for Free Albania, dated May 23 from Pristina, Yugoslavia. The writer states that he remains in good health but that Adem Gjuraj, the leader of the team, has gone out of his mind and is in a Yugoslav hospital.
