DAILY REPORT - TUESDAY 26 JUNE 1951

BGFLEND

1. King Zog, former Albanian monarch, will leave 1 July for the United States, accompanied by 3 members of his staff.

2. It is planned that the aircraft which will ferry the 16 Albanians to Greece, when they have completed their training in Germany, will return to Germany on or about 13 July with a plane-load of Albanians for the Guard Company. To date this number is undetermined pending completion of physical examinations but the Assessment Team reported 66 operational candidates at Lavrion IRO camp where these future members of the Guard Company are presently located.

QKSTAR

1. The preliminary report from two survivors of FOX team, whose destination was the Tetevin area in northwest Bulgaria, indicates that there definitely is a large resistance movement of 150 men in the mountains near Sliven. This resistance group includes an army lieutenant. The report also confirms resistance activities in the Tetevin area by a group of 200 to 250 men who have sabotaged certain factories and have been involved in clashes with the authorities.

2. FOX team sent a courier to contact the resistance movement in the Sliven area and through that group the movement in the Tetevin area.

3. The one member of the FOX team who was killed while trying to return to Greece in early June, was dragged 25 kilometres to Petrich behind a cart and exhibited with prepared anti-Western demonstrations.

4. Indicates that although the defection and death are unfortunate and disturbing, they have definitely proved beneficial in terms of increased experience for surviving agents and in terms of the psychological change of attitude within the surviving agents, who now are motivated by strong patriotic feelings and determination.

5. Infiltration round-ups:

(a) FOX teams: 2 men exfiltrating for the second time were ambushed at the Greek border; one agent and 2 recruits escaped—the fate of the others is unknown, but they were probably killed. Two Dreamer soldiers were killed.

(b) MOLE team: one man, who is doubling on the Motorola, continues to make radio contact but small hope is held that he might
