

BOFIEND

1. The visit of the military junta to the BOFIEND covert training school, July 3/4, has been reported as a success. The members of the junta found morale high, and complimented the staff on the training program.

2. Final arrangements have been made for the transfer of 16 fully trained Albanians from Germany to Athens on July 14. In the event the operation does not run on schedule, it will be set up for the following day. The ferrying airplane will return to Germany with approximately 50 Albanians on board, who will be added to the Guard Company.

3. A Yugoslav source has advised the CFA that 18 men were dropped into Albania on May 24 by the Yugoslav-sponsored Albanian committee. The report states that this group battled security police in the Puka area and lost two of their members. In addition, the report states that the Yugoslav-sponsored committee has over 100 agents currently active in Albania.

4. [redacted] is currently en route to Germany, where he will be added to the staff of the Guard Company as [redacted] assistant. [redacted] knowledge of Albanian and his familiarity with basic military training should make him a valuable addition to the FIEND organization.

5. [redacted] a communications technician and an addition to the [redacted] radio station in Athens, is now en route [redacted]

OKSTAIR

1. Preliminary interrogation of the Bulgarian agent who was captured by the Bulgarian authorities but who managed to "escape" to Greece last week gives the following information:

(a) The agent was taken to Sofia, where he was subjected to interrogations which were mild in nature in spite of the fact that he was caught in a number of lies, and although he was confronted by one of our agents who defected to the Communists after being infiltrated last May. It is not yet possible to ascertain whether the agent actually "escaped" or whether he has become a "double agent" for the Bulgarian authorities.

(b) The above-mentioned defector has generally blown the German training facilities where he received his instruction, as well as the facilities in Greece through which he was staged prior to entering Bulgaria. The full extent of the disclosure is not yet determined, but on the basis of what is known so far [redacted] as indicated that he sees no need to alter the installations which were revealed.

(c) The escaped agent noticed a considerable number of Russian soldiers in Bulgaria. In addition, he was informed that many Russians were moving toward the Yugoslav border.
